A NEW TOMORROW

COVID-19 AND TOURISM

In this crisis, we have an opportunity to rethink how tourism interacts with our societies, other economic sectors, and our natural resources, and to measure and manage it better, to ensure a fair distribution of its benefits, and to advance the transition toward a carbon-neutral and resilient tourism industry.

To balance the massive effects on lives and economies, the brief makes recommendations in five priority areas. It outlines how the governments are supporting the sector, calls for a reopening that prioritizes workers, travelers, and host communities, and provides a roadmap to transform tourism.

UNPRECEDENTED ECONOMIC IMPACTS

- Tourism is one of the world's most important economic sectors. In 2019, it accounted for 7% of global trade (after fuels and chemicals).
- In some countries, it can represent over 20% of their GDP, and it is overall the third-largest export sector in the world.
- Tourism is one of the sectors most affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, impacting economies, livelihoods, public services, and opportunities on all continents. All parts of its vast value chain have been affected.

- Tourism export revenues are expected to fall by \$910 billion to \$1.2 trillion in 2020. Global GDP could be reduced by 1.5% to 2.8% as a result.
- Both in developing and developed economies, tourism supports one out of every ten jobs and provides livelihoods for many millions more.
- There are dozens and dozens of Small Island Developing States (SIDS) whose economies depend heavily on tourism, while it contributes to developing and developed countries' economies alike.



POSSIBLE SCENARIOS FOR 2021

The three scenarios presented below are consistent with UNWTO (2021b) projections for 2021.

In the first scenario, tourists will arrive in fewer numbers in 2020 than they did in 2017. The reductions averaged 74 percent, with considerable variation between countries. Compared to UNWTO's pessimistic scenario, this average reduction is close to 75 percent.

The second scenario is a reduction in arrivals averaging 63 percent, which the UNWTO sees as an optimistic outcome in 2021.

The third scenario assumes a reduction of 75 percent in countries with low vaccination rates and a reduction of 37 percent in those with relatively high vaccination rates3. According to Our World in Data4, 55 such countries exist. This includes major destination countries such as the United States, Italy, France, and Spain as well as many smaller ones.

Let's look at some recent technological advances so that everyone understands what to look for, embrace, and take with them.


Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence (AI)
