

Communication – The most important aspect of our life

"Communication plays a vital role in all areas of our life. Excellent Communication is a prerequisite in almost every role in our personal and professional life."

Our ability to succeed in anything depends on our ability to influence and inspire others through our spoken and written words. There are different elements of "Communications" like verbal, non-verbal (smiling, eye-contact), speaking, listening & writing to name a few.

However, there are different styles on how we "Communicate with others".

PASSIVE COMMUNICATOR

Usually, passive communicators are very quiet. They can be resistant to debates and never take a firm stand or asset themselves.

Some of the key identifications of a Passive Communicator are:

Difficulty making eye contact Inability to say "No"

Go with the flow type attitude

The Ability to say "No"

Poor Posture

AGGRESSIVE COMMUNICATOR

The aggressive communicators are considered arrogant, sarcastic and opportunistic. It shows up as bossy, lacking gratitude and disrespectful behavior. It affects long term relationships and the effectiveness of their interpersonal skills.

Some of the key identifications of an Aggressive Communicator are:

Gestures like crossed arms Intense eye contact Poor listening or interrupting frequently Mocking behavior

ASSERTIVE COMMUNICATORS

The Assertive Communicators are considered the most successful communicators. They communicate their wants, expectations, thoughts and emotions very well. They also consider other people needs. They take on challenges, but know when to say "No".

Some of the key identifications of an Assertive Communicator are :

A Clear voice Good eye contact Encourages balanced conversations in which both people have a chance to speak

PASSIVE-AGGRESSIVE COMMUNICATORS

Passive-Aggressive communicators are passive in their communication but they are still frustrated and discontented under their surface. Their acts always don't agree with what they say.

Some of the key identifications of a Passive-Aggressive Communicator are:

Using Sarcasm
Presenting a happy face through obviously irritated
Difficulty acknowledging emotions
Words don't match actions

Now that we have analyzed the different styles of communicators, we know all these different personalities exist in the work place and how we will communicate with them is an art.
