

As our community grows and strengthens, we request all of you to send in your suggestions and keep in action!




Entrepreneur Spotlight





What social media platform would you recommend to do business on?

LinkedIn is the most effective business platform in North America, followed by a slew of others, including Instagram, Tik Tok, and Facebook.

How do you create a social media calendar?

How frequently should one post and so on. - Our calendar is divided into three sections: LinkedIn, Instagram, and Facebook. Our goal is to post on all three platforms at least three times per week. We keep up with business trends. For example, the best days to post on LinkedIn are Wednesdays and Thursdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. (EST)
