

Training initiative is an "input" which is the most essential for an organisation's growth, profitability, employee retention & motivation.


Being an important tool of the human capital strategy, the best of the organisations get it wrong when it comes to allocation of resources for training.

I landed on some pages where John talks about Strengsfinder and his top five strengths. Funny thing, wouldn't you know it ... I'm a Gallup-certified Strengths Coach – WHAAAAAAAAAAAAT?!?!?!

The premise of Cliffton Strengths is that the most effective way to develop and empower people is to help them use their strengths.

According to a Gallup, people who focus on their strengths are THREE TIMES as likely to report having an excellent quality of life. One of the reasons why I believe strongly in this is because everything is connected: work impacts home which impacts community and everything in between. When we're able to leverage our strengths regardless of where we're at or who we're with, there's a greater chance we'll also report having an excellent quality of life.







